As a sustainable festival, it is important to us, to keep our ecological footprint as small as possible and reduce our consumption of resources. This involves a certain number of criteria that we, the organizers, wish to implement:

The organizer:

- Our decoration is made from recycled or recyclable materials
 - We avoid plastic as much as possible
 - We try to be Paperless as best as possible
 - Our posters and flyers are printed on recycled paper
 - Signs and markings for waste sorting
 - A large number of our products are organic, local, regional and/or fair trade
 - We offer vegetarian/vegan alternatives to all meat menus
 - Free drinking-water station for filling up cans or bottles
 - Eco-friendly cleaning agents
 - No single-use items. For all meals, reusable utensils (cutlery, plates, wooden board) will be provided. For drinks, reusable cups, glasses and mugs will be available.
 - Bicycle racks are located at the entrance to the site
 - Free shuttle buses run every 15-minute from the train station in Munsbach and from several bus stops in the industrial zone 'Parc d'activité Syrdall' to the festival entrance - Only one paid car park 800m from the festival site
- What we would like from you:
- Please use the recycling stations on site (see signs)
 - Please avoid plastic bags or single-use packaging when transporting your products - Use decorative materials that conserve resources and are recyclable
 - Bring and use LED lamps instead of conventional ones
 - Due to limited parking space, we recommend carpooling
 - Please use our rubbish bins, the forest and nature will thank you
